#### **Where the Past Begins** Palibrio

"Nineteen Eighty-Four: A Novel", often published as "1984", is a dystopian social science fiction novel by English novelist George Orwell. It was published on 8 June 1949 by Secker & Warburg as Orwell's ninth and final book completed in his lifetime. Thematically, "Nineteen Eighty-Four" centres on the consequences of totalitarianism, mass surveillance, and

repressive regimentation of persons and behaviours within society. Orwell, himself a democratic socialist, modelled the authoritarian government in the novel after Stalinist Russia. More broadly, the novel examines the role of truth and facts within politics and the ways in which they are manipulated. The story takes place in an imagined future, the year 1984, when much of the world has fallen victim to perpetual war, omnipresent government surveillance, historical negationism, and propaganda. Great Britain, known as Airstrip One, has become a province of a totalitarian superstate named Oceania that is ruled by the Party who employ the Thought Police to persecute individuality and independent thinking. Big Brother, the leader of the Party, enjoys an intense cult of personality despite the fact that he may not even exist. The protagonist, Winston Smith, is a diligent and skillful rank-and-file worker and Outer Party member who secretly hates the Party and dreams of rebellion. ## THE ALCHEMIST

El turismo se viene estudiando con asiduidad desde fines del siglo XIX, cuando ya lo practicaban las clases medias urbanas. Los primeros estudiosos, los hoteleros, adoptaron el concepto de

turista que décadas antes habían encontrado los hablantes y crearon el derivado turismo. Cuando, ya en el siglo XX, se ocuparon los profesores universitarios de esta parcela de la realidad social, no averiguaron antes si la noción vulgar permitía fundar sobre ella un corpus teórico sólido. Para ellos, para la gente y para los hoteleros, turismo es lo que hacen los turistas (consumidores) y lo que hacen los hoteleros (productores). Como el mismo término designa lo mismo la demanda que la oferta, se crea una grave confusión en el análisis. Si se añade que aún no se ha encontrado una definición satisfactoria de turista, no es extraño que se diga que el estudio del turismo es enigmático y bizarro, una compleja realidad que ninguna ciencia social puede desentrañar por sí sola. El Turismo explicado con claridad demuestra que si de lo que se trata es de conocer el turismo para invertir en negocios, hay que estudiarlo, entonces, como la microeconomía se acerca al estudio de cualquier actividad productiva. La obra formula un modelo alternativo, económico o de oferta, al modelo convencional, sociológico o de demanda, y termina con una recapitulación en la que se analizan mitos o lugares comunes del turismo tales como que el turismo es "tan antiguo como la humanidad" o que es "la primera industria mundial".

Fourth Estate

Based around the pivotal WWII battle of Stalingrad (1942-3), where the German advance into Russia was eventually halted by the Red Army, and around an extended family, the Shaposhnikovs, and their many friends and acquaintances, Life and Fate recounts the experience of characters caught up in an immense struggle between opposing armies and ideologies.

Nazism and Communism are appallingly similar, 'two poles of one magnet', as a German camp commander tells a shocked old Bolshevik prisoner. At the height of the battle Russian soldiers and citizens alike are at last able to speak out as they choose, and without reprisal - an unexpected and short-lived moment of freedom. Grossman himself was on the front line as a war correspondent at Stalingrad - hence his gripping battle scenes, though these are more than matched by the drama of the individual conscience struggling against massive pressure to submit to the State. He knew all about this from experience too. His central character, Viktor Shtrum, eventually succumbs, but each delay and act of resistance is a moral victory. Though he writes unsparingly of war, terror and totalitarianism, Grossman also tells of the acts of 'senseless kindness' that redeem humanity, and his message remains one of hope. He dedicates his book, the labour of ten years, and which he did not live to see published, to his mother, who, like Viktor Shtrum's, was killed in the holocaust at Berdichev in Ukraine in September 1941.

### **Mother Of Pearl** Grupo Planeta Spain

A chilling novel about the nightmare of a corrupt and brutal dictatorship. The star of Roberto Bolano's hair-raising novel *Distant Star* is Alberto Ruiz-Tagle, an air force pilot who exploits the 1973 coup to launch his own version of the New Chilean Poetry, a multimedia enterprise involving sky-writing, poetry, torture, and photo exhibitions. For our unnamed narrator, who first encounters this "star" in a college poetry workshop, Ruiz-

Tagle becomes the silent hand behind every evil act in the darkness of Pinochet's regime. The narrator, unable to stop himself, tries to track Ruiz-Tagle down, and sees signs of his activity over and over again. A corrosive, mocking humor sparkles within Bolano's darkest visions of Chile under Pinochet. In Bolano's world there's a big graveyard and there's a big graveyard laugh. (He once described his novel *By Night in Chile* as "a tale of terror, a situation comedy, and a combination pastoral-gothic novel.") Many Chilean authors have written about the "bloody events of the early Pinochet years, the abductions and murders," Richard Eder commented in the *The New York Times*: "None has done it in so dark and glittering a fashion as Roberto Bolano."

*Life and Fate* Simon and Schuster

As one of the first successful Latin crossover artists, Jon Secada dominated the pop music charts in the early 90s, releasing hits such as *Just Another Day* and *Angel* and winning multiple Grammy Awards. As a Cuban refugee, Jon understands that life is about starting anew and embracing opportunities, something he never lost sight of while achieving his dream of being a performer and while building new dreams when life took unexpected turns. In his debut book, Jon shares the lessons he learned that made him the resilient person he is today.
