The first edition of *Seizures in Critical Care: A Guide to Diagnosis and Therapeutics*, which appeared in 2005, filled an important need in the armamentarium of the neurological, neurosurgical, and medical intensivists who deal with seriously ill patients in the ICU setting. Unlike epilepsy, as it usually presents in the outpatient department, seizures in ICU patients are nearly always secondary phenomena that signify that something is seriously amiss in very ill patients with primary medical or surgical disease.
