A pesar de los avances de la neurociencia y de las ciencias cognitivas en los últimos cincuenta años, el estudio de la percepción abarca un campo en el que todavía no se dispone de una teoría unificada desde la cual se pueda dar cuenta de todos los fenómenos y procesos involucrados. Sin embargo, no se puede desconocer la vigencia y pertinencia que tiene el estudio de la percepción para diferentes disciplinas.
