Readers are provided a set of methodologies to build genuine community relationships, knowledge, power, and spaces for themselves. This book offers a critical and concrete map for community making that leverages Indigenous way-finding tools. Mvskoke narratives thread throughout the text, vividly demonstrating that theories come from lived and felt experiences.
