The Vibrant Exchange French – No
Longer Your Dull Draw! In the first book
ever exclusively devoted to the
Exchange French Variation, American
grandmaster Alex Fishbein recognizes
that the Exchange French is an opening
for a player who likes active piece play,
fights for the initiative, excels in
positions with possibilities on both sides
of the board, and finds strategic and
tactical nuances that arise out of almost
nothing. And if you play the French as
Black, then this book will help you deal
with White's 3.exd5. Authors of French
Defense books from the black
perspective have recognized for a while
that there is no draw here at all and
have proposed lines where Black can
create interesting play. Indeed, both
sides can create complications. The
author shows that playing "boring"
moves is actually risky with both White
and Black. The Exchange French is a
vibrant opening, just like any other, and
yet there has been very little literature
showing how to play it from the white
side. That void is filled with this book.
While the main point of this book is to
build a White repertoire, any player of
the Black side of the French will benefit
by reading it. A good number of the
sample games end well for Black,
whereas in the games in which White
gains the upper hand, Fishbein is careful
to note improvements for the second
player. I have been playing and writing
about the French Defense, including this
variation, for many years, but I came
across a lot that I hadn't known in nearly
every sub-variation. "I suspect that most

readers of this book will be pleasantly
surprised to find out how rich the play
can become in the French Exchange
Variation. That alone is enough to
reward a careful reading, and Fishbein's
careful exposition of lines and strategies
will undoubtedly translate into extra
points over the board. – from the

San Antonio 1972 was either the strongest chess tournament ever played in the history of the United States or, if not the very strongest, then second only to New York 1924. What makes this book especially great is not merely was it a great tournament with great players, but that the players annotated some of their own games. In this day and age, there are millions of games in the chess databases, but annotated games are increasingly hard to find. This book has games annotated by Karpov, Larsen, Hort, Suttles, Mecking, Donald Byrne, Gligoric, Keres, Saidy, Portisch, Kaplan, Evans and Smith. Two games were annotated by both Larsen and Petrosian. In addition, many of the games were annotated by International Master David Levy. This book was originally published in Descriptive Chess Notation. Since that time, Descriptive has become almost obsolete. For that reason, all 120 games in this book have been converted into modern Algebraic Notation and are included in an appendix in the back of the book. The games in the back are grouped and sorted alphabetically according to the player of the white pieces. Thus, all games in which Browne played White are first, followed by the games by Byrne, Campos-Lopez, Evans, Gligoric, Hort, Kaplan, Karpov, Keres, Larsen, Mecking, Petrosian, Portisch, Saidy and Smith in that order.

Bent Larsen (1935-2010) was one of the greatest fighters chess has ever seen. In his rich career the great Dane defeated all World Champions from Botvinnik to Karpov. He was a Candidate for the World Championship four times and became one of the most successful

tournament players of his time. His uncompromising style and his unorthodox thinking made him popular with chess players all around the globe. In 1967/1968 Larsen won five international elite events in a row, a truly spectacular achievement. His successes were such that Bobby Fischer let him play first board in the legendary match Soviet Union vs. the World in 1970 in Belgrade. Bent Larsen also was a highly original chess writer and an extremely productive chess journalist. Not surprisingly the first chess book that Magnus Carlsen ever studied was written by the strongest Scandinavian player before him. This collection brings together more than 120 of Bent Larsen's best games, annotated by himself. His comments are lucid, to the point, instructive and humorous.
