Charges of abandoned standards issue from government offices; laments for the loss of the best that has been thought and said resound through university corridors. While revisionists are perplexed by questions of value, critical theory--haunted by the heresy of relativism--remains captive to

classical formulas. Barbara Herrnstein Smith's book confronts the conceptual problems and sociopolitical conflicts at the heart of these issues and raises their discussion to a new level of sophistication. Polemical without being rancorous, *Contingencies of Value* mounts a powerful critique of traditional conceptions of value, taste, judgment, and justification. that makes possible our moral discoveries, such as the wrongness of slavery. 
