Also of note is the author's progressively matter-of-fact portrait of the lesbian romance between his novel's only sympathetic characters, Claudine and Orleana. This edition marks the first time that *The Mysteries of New Orleans* has been translated into English and proves that 150 years later, this vast, strange, and important novel remains as compelling as ever.
