Este libro reflexiona en torno a las implicaciones de la actual configuración constitucional de los derechos y sus garantías, derivadas de la reforma de 2011, partiendo de una concepción amplia de los derechos humanos que incluye a los económicos, sociales y culturales y a toda una serie de derechos que se han venido reconociendo desde las últimas décadas del siglo xx hasta nuestros días, como los derechos de la mujer y los derechos colectivos de los pueblos indígenas. Los trabajos aquí reunidos se ocupan principalmente de un cierto tipo de implicaciones, las de tipo teórico-conceptual, de orden metodológico o interpretativo y las de tipo histórico, ya que estas son determinantes para la eficacia de esta reforma, que nos obliga a repensar y reconceptualizar nuestra idea de los derechos constitucionales y su protección. El autor sostiene que las implicaciones de la reforma en materia de derechos humanos tienen que ir más lejos, lo que implica hacer una revisión doctrinal profunda. Entre estas, se encuentran las de orden conceptual, que nos obligan a analizar los conceptos de “derechos humanos”, “derechos constitucionales”, “interés legítimo”, entre otros, y atender a los cambios producidos al haberse abandonado otros conceptos. La tesis que se defiende sostiene que la centralidad que tiene el concepto de “derechos humanos” nos debe llevar a un cambio en nuestra doctrina constitucional; los constitucionalistas tienen ahora la obligación de adecuar sus teorías dogmáticas a este cambio conceptual. El análisis aquí presentado no solo es el de un constitucionalista, sino el de un filósofo o teórico del derecho que trata de advertir sobre algunos de los retos que ahora tienen enfrente los constitucionalistas. Se intenta orientar cómo entender estos desafíos y ensayar, a partir de la experiencia del autor, en temas de derechos humanos que permitan visualizar algunos temas, problemas y sus soluciones.

Why did Spanish American nationalists in 1819 name a new independent republic "Colombia," after Columbus, the first representative of the empire from which they had recently broken free? Columbus, who had been construed as a figure of empire for centuries, fit perfectly into that framework. By adopting him as a national symbol, New World nationalists appeal to Old World notions of empire.

When are borders justified? Who has a right to control them? Where should they be drawn? Today people think of borders as an island's shores. Just as beaches delimit a castaway's realm, so borders define the edges of a territory, occupied by a unified people, to whom the land legitimately belongs. Hence a territory is legitimate only if it belongs to a people unified by a civic identity. Sadly, this Desert Island Model of territorial politics forces us to choose. If we want territories, then we can either have democratic legitimacy, or inclusion of different civic identities--but not both. The resulting politics creates mass xenophobia, migrant-bashing, hoarding of natural resources, and border walls. To escape all this, *On Borders* presents an alternative model. Drawing on an intellectual tradition concerned with how land and climate shape institutions, it argues that we should not see territories as pieces of property owned by identity groups. Instead, we should see them as watersheds: as interconnected systems where institutions, people, the biota, and the land together create overlapping civic duties and relations, what the book calls place-specific duties. This Watershed Model argues that borders are justified when they allow us to fulfill those duties; that border-control rights spring from internationally-agreed conventions--not from internal legitimacy; that borders should be governed cooperatively by the neighboring states and the states system; and that border redrawing should be done with environmental conservation in mind. The book explores how this model undoes the exclusionary politics of desert

islands.

A fresh, comprehensive biography of the pioneering educator and activist who changed the way we look at children's minds, from the author of Oriana Fallaci. Born in 1870 in Chiaravalle, Italy, Maria Montessori would grow up to embody almost every trait men of her era detested in the fairer sex. She was self-confident, strong-willed, and had a fiery temper at a time when women were supposed to be soft and pliable. She studied until she became a doctor at a time when female graduates in Italy provoked outright scandal. She never wanted to marry or have children—the accepted destiny for all women of her milieu in late nineteenth-century bourgeois Rome—and when she became pregnant by a colleague of hers, she gave up her son to continue pursuing her career. In spite of the resistance she faced from all sides—scientists accused her of being too mystical, and the clergy of being too scientific, traditionalists of giving children too much freedom, and anarchists of giving them too much structure—she would garner acclaim and establish the influential Montessori method, which is now practiced throughout the world. A thorough, nuanced portrait of this often controversial woman, *The Child Is the Teacher* offers an unbiased perspective from an author who is not a member of the Montessori movement, but who has been granted access to original letters, diaries, notes, and texts written by Montessori herself, including an array of previously unpublished material.
