The conviction that the development and promotion of the arts, humanities and culture through the study of literature and the aesthetic are the fundamental constituents of any progress in society is at the heart of this volume. The essays gathered here explore the role of the imagination and aesthetic awareness in an age when the corporatization of knowledge is in the process of transforming literary studies, and political commitment is in danger of disappearing behind a supposedly post-ideological late-capitalist consensus. The main focus of the volume is the mutual implication of aesthetics and ideology and the status and

value of different types of art within the political arena. Challenging issues in contemporary aesthetics are examined within the wider framework of current debates on the disappearance of the real, the crisis in representation, and the use of new media. The wide range of examples collected here, stretching from experimental poetry in post-war Germany, political commitment in twentieth-century French theatre, and countercultural Rumanian theatre under Ceaușescu, to Neo-Victorian fiction, Verbatim theatre in the UK, and political theatre for the masses in Estonia, vouchsafe unique insights into the intersection of aesthetics and ideology and the practical consequences thereof. As such, the volume opens up a space for a meaningful engagement with authentic forms of art from inside and outside the Anglosphere, and, ultimately, uses these examples as a platform from which to imagine some form of “aesthetics”, representing an ideal union of aesthetics and ideology. This concept, first coined by the French philosopher Philippe Lacoue-Labarthe, will prove to be relevant both within the parameters of the examples discussed

here, but also beyond, for the contributors to this volume are unanimous in refusing to believe that aesthetics and ideology can exist one without the other, and in recognizing the centrality of ethics in any discussion of these notions.

**The Art of the Project** Lavoisier Every artist has a dream project an enterprise that he or she has continuously taken up but never completed. Via archived notes and drafts, a retrospective reconstitution of such projects can serve as a key for better understanding the authors artistic corpus. The present study reaches out to the authorship of Paul Claudel, Jean Genet, and Federico Fellini. Claudel deferred and never completed the fourth segment of his *Trilogie des Coufontaine*. The only indication of the existence of this prospective fourth part of the theatre sequence is a brief entry in his *Journal*. In 1949, he began writing a third version of his first great work *Tête d'Or*. Like the unfinished fourth section that was to be added to the trilogy, the draft of the third version of *Tête d'Or* reveals a dialogue between the Old and New Testaments a theme that appears to be central to Claudel's entire corpus. Genet

labored over *La Mort* for many years. At the conclusion of *Saint Genet, comédien et martyr* (1952), Sartre mentions this final work of Genet. Genet discussed his progress on *La Mort* in correspondence and even published *Fragments of La Mort* in the literary magazine *Les Temps Modernes*. While the project never came to fruition, it nevertheless remains an important means through which to understand Genet's work. The aborted production of Fellini's *Voyage de G. Mastorna* has become a legend. After 8" and *Giulietta degli spiriti*, Fellini wrote a screenplay that he began to film but subsequently abandoned, much to the chagrin of producer Dino de Laurentiis who had already invested in sets and costumes. Fellini would often revisit this project, but never completed it. This book also examines additional dream projects taken from different art forms: poetry (Mallarmés *Le Livre*); literature (Vignys *Daphné*); painting (Monet's *Nymphéas*); music (Schoenberg's *Moses und Aron*); and various films (Clouzot's *LEnfer*, Viscontis *La Recherche*, Kubricks *Napoleon*, etc.).

The first English-language translation of an essential, early work key to understanding the French philosopher's later thought. In the decade prior to the publication of *Inner Experience* (*L'expérience intérieure*), the twentieth-century French philosopher Georges Bataille produced a nascent masterwork containing some of his most original and extensive reflections on a range of subjects. With thoughts on ritual sacrifice and military conquest, the nature of laughter, and the mechanisms of capitalism, *The Limit of the Useful*, as Bataille had planned to title the work, illuminates the philosopher's later corpus, yet it remained unfinished and unpublished in his lifetime, and untranslated until now. This is the first English-language translation of what Cory Austin Knudson and Tomas Elliott argue is one of Bataille's most structurally consistent works. Paired with draft essays

and plans for *The Accursed Share*, along with over a hundred pages of appendixes and notes, the volume distinctively elaborates Bataille's thought. *The Limit of the Useful* spans a decade of rich intellectual ferment in Bataille's life as he first formulated his challenge to capitalism, engaging with concepts and ideas in ways not seen in his other published works. The volume bridges the gap between Bataille's surrealist literary writings and later scientific pretensions, drawing attention to, and filling in, an overlooked lacuna in his oeuvre.

EXCERPT Is there such a thing as the Brussels spirit? Indeed there is, in the sense that it summarizes the sometimes surreal country that produced René Magritte. If there were no Brussels, Belgium would surely not exist, for Brussels is the keystone to the country's structure. However, the capital of Belgium is weakened by institutional complexity, wedged as it is between the Flemish and Walloon regions. Furthermore the Brussels spirit is inseparable from the Brussels accent, which is indispensable for uttering

expressions such as 'Arrête une fois de zieverer, dikkenek!'<sup>1</sup> Not to be confused with the Belgian accent, which doesn't really exist anyway. And then there is the city's international status. How many cities can boast that they have an airline named after them? 'It's because Brussels is a strong brand name', we are told, even stronger than Belgium's. If that is true, it is thanks to Europe and its 12 stars, which brought the city out of provincial obscurity and placed it squarely on the world stage. The economic benefits from the presence of the European Union are obvious, even though the average Bruxellois loves to criticize Eurocrat salaries, considered outrageous by many.
