altering the incentives that operate inside market institutions. Chapters include Robert Stavins on market-based environmental policy, Archon Fung on 'social markets' and Cary Coglianese and David Lazer. The final section examines both the upside and the downside of the market-based approach to improving governance. Contributors include Elaine Kamarck, John D. Donahue, Mark Moore, and Robert Behn. An introduction by John D. Donahue frames market-based governance as an effort to engineer into public work some of the 'intensive' accountability that characterizes markets without surrendering the 'extensive' accountability of conventional government. A preface by Joseph S. Nye Jr. sets the book in the context of a

larger inquiry into the future of governance.
