Much of the book was dictated to several of Crowley's students, who would also ask questions to get clarification. The principal collaborators were Mary Deste Sturges (Soror Virakam, mother of Preston Sturges), Leila Waddell (also known as Laylah), and Mary Butts, all of whom were given co-authorship credit.
