Guli Francis-Dehqani was born in Isfahan, Iran, to a family who were part of the tiny Anglican Church established by 19th century missionaries. Her father, a Muslim convert, became the first

Guli's father was briefly imprisoned before surviving an attack on his life, which injured his wife.
