The fierce battle over identity and patriotism within Cherokee culture that took place in the years surrounding the Trail of Tears. Though the tragedy of the Trail of Tears is widely recognized today, the pervasive effects of the tribe's uprooting have never been examined in detail. Despite the Cherokees' efforts to assimilate with the dominant white culture—running their own newspaper, ratifying a constitution based on that of the United States—they were never able to integrate fully

with white men in the New World.
