Featuring a rare interview with Prost, and insight from Martin Brundle, Damon Hill, Sir Frank Williams, Bernie Ecclestone, Derek Warwick, Johnny Herbert, Gerhard Berger, plus McLaren insiders and other F1 figures, Malcolm Folley provides us with a breath-taking account of one of the all-time classic sporting rivalries.

No dia 1 de maio de 1994, antes da partida para o Grande Prémio de São Marino, em Imola, o piloto brasileiro Ayrton Senna, referindo-se à perigosíssima curva de Tamburello, dizia: «Ali, se houver um problema, só me resta fazer o sinal da cruz.» Estas terríveis palavras soariam como uma premonição.
