Belenggu Papa Mertua Simon and Schuster Situated along the line that divides the rich ecologies of Asia and Australia, the Indonesian archipelago is a hotbed for scientific exploration, and scientists from around the world have made key discoveries there. But why do the names of Indonesia's own scientists rarely appear in the annals of scientific history? In *The Floracrats* Andrew Goss examines the professional lives of Indonesian naturalists and biologists, to show what happens to science when a powerful state becomes its greatest, and indeed only,

patron. With only one purse to pay for research, Indonesia's scientists followed a state agenda focused mainly on exploiting the country's most valuable natural resources—above all its major export crops: quinine, sugar, coffee, tea, rubber, and indigo. The result was a class of botanic bureaucrats that Goss dubs the “floracrats.” Drawing on archives and oral histories, he shows how these scientists strove for the Enlightenment ideal of objective, universal, and useful knowledge, even as they betrayed that ideal by failing to share scientific knowledge with the general public. With each chapter, Goss details the phases of power and the personalities in

Indonesia that have struggled with this dilemma, from the early colonial era, through independence, to the modern Indonesian state. Goss shows just how limiting dependence on an all-powerful state can be for a scientific community, no matter how idealistic its individual scientists may be.

First published in 1922, the novel "Sitti Nurbaya: A Love Unrealized," by Marah Rusli, retains the poignancy that made it a modern Indonesian classic. In terms of its social impact in what was then the Dutch East Indies, "Sitti Nurbaya" may be

compared to "Uncle Tom's Cabin" in the ante-bellum United States. Even to this day, the issues of injustice and indignities suffered by women that this novel raised continue to be debated throughout the country. Rich in description, dense with ironic foreboding and the inexorable workings of fate, Sitti Nurbaya is Samsu and "Sitti Nurbaya"'s ill-fated love story. But in their wishes, the reader might also discern young people's tantalizing dream of what the East Indies society might become, or could become, if only local genius, embodied in a modernizing youth emancipated from stifling traditions, could fuse with European genius in mutual

respect and admiration. This too was, of course, a dream never to be realized, and one perhaps which never could have been realized.

This compilation of translations of modern Indonesian literature originated as a series of class exercises performed by some of my students at Cornell University as a part of the advanced Indonesian language class during the years 1952-1955. The selections have now been compiled primarily for use in a course on Southeast Asian Literature in Translation, in an attempt to overcome, to some extent, the

lack of available material. These are presented herewith in the hope that they may also be of interest to others concerned with, or interested in, comparative or Far Eastern literature. In addition to the selections translated by these students, several poems which Messrs. Burton Raffel and Nurdin Salam kindly sent me from Makassar have been included together with two translations by Professor Harry J. Benda of the University of Rochester. Indonesian literature since 1917 has indeed been a terra incognita for several reasons, two of the most obvious being the inaccessibility of the material and the language barrier. Both of these are very

slowly but gradually being broken down, as a glance at James S. Holmes' *Angkatan Muda, A Checklist of Writings in Western Language Translations in Indonesia* 5, pp. 462-72, will reveal. It is my hope that this anthology will assist in dispelling some of the ignorance which now inevitably prevails concerning modern Indonesian literature. With the appearance in June of the Atlantic supplement, *Perspective of Indonesia* further opportunity will be given Americans and others to become acquainted with a sample of the literature of this area. In preparing this anthology I have often been reminded of a story, probably apocryphal, related

about Einstein who, shortly after his arrival in this country, was asked to say a few words and replied that he would try to speak in English but if by chance he should slip back into German, Dr. Lindemann would 'traduce' him. I sincerely hope that none of the writers represented in this compilation has been traduced. I cannot conclude without acknowledging the assistance of Idrus Nazir Djajadiningrat and Hassan Shadily in carefully checking many of the translations and of Mrs. Tazu Warner, secretary in the Department of Far Eastern Studies at Cornell University, who performed an excellent job of typing the mats for reproduction and assisted in numerous

other ways. Finally I wish to express my appreciation to the Djakarta publishing houses, Balai Pustaka (Perpustakaan Perguruan Kementerian - P.P.&K.) and Pustaka Rakjat for granting permission to reproduce these translations of their publications. - John M. Echols

Dalam kesusastaaran Indonesia modern, kritik sastra ilmiah baru muncul pada awal tahun 1950-an, berupa tulisan-tulisan Slametmuljana. Mulai saat itu, berkembanglah kritik sastra ilmiah pada

kurun waktu 1950-1970 secara perlahan-lahan, terutama ditulis oleh para mahasiswa Slametmuljana dan H.B. Jassin sebagai skripsi sarjana sastra, yang kebanyakan dipengaruhi oleh aliran New Criticism. Namun, kritik mereka belum menggunakan teori sastra atau kritik sastra yang jelas, yaitu campuran bermacam-macam teori sastra ilmiah yang sering kali saling bertentangan. Pada tahun 1980-an, banyak teori sastra baru mulai masuk ke Indonesia, seperti strukturalisme, sosiologi sastra, semiotika, estetika resepsi, dekonstruksi, dan kritik feminis. Namun, tidak mudah menerapkan teori dan kritik sastra tersebut dalam penelitian

sastra. Berangkat dari fenomena itulah tulisan-tulisan dalam buku ini dimaksudkan untuk menanggapi atau mengantisipasi masuknya teori-teori dan kritik sastra yang baru, di samping juga untuk menanggapi kesusastraan Indonesia sendiri, terutama kesusastraan Indonesia modern. Teori dan metode kritik sastra tersebut yang semuanya untuk konkretisasi dipandang dari sudut pandang teori tertentu. Namun, tidak semua teori sastra dan kritik sastra dapat dipaparkan di dalam buku ini. Pembahasan dalam buku ini hanya melingkupi teori sastra dan kritik sastra strukturalisme dan semiotik, serta teori dan metode estetika resepsi yang sekarang

sedang banyak dipelajari dalam kritik sastra ilmiah. Teori dan metode yang berhubungan dengan strukturalisme dan semiotik dalam buku ini adalah "Penelitian dengan Pendekatan Semiotik", "Hubungan Intertekstual dalam Sastra Indonesia" , dan "Hubungan Intertekstual Roman-roman Balai Pustaka dan Pujangga Baru". Teori-teori yang berhubungan dengan

estetika resepsi dalam buku ini ialah "Estetika Resepsi dan Teori Penerapannya", "Tinjauan Resepsi Sastra Beberapa Sajak Chairil Anwar", dan "Tanggapan Pembaca terhadap Belunggu". Dalam ketiga tulisan itu dikemukakan teori dan metode estetika resepsi dan novel Belunggu karya Armijn Pane yang sampai sekarang tetap mendapat resepsi pembaca.

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
