 The current revival of the work of Maeve Brennan, who died in obscurity in 1993, has won her a reputation as a twentieth-century classic—one of the best Irish writers of stories since Joyce. These root-starting terms then are followed by terms where the root falls behind the word, e.g., acouesthesia and

acoumeter. These words are followed by words where the root falls in the middle or the end, as in such terms as bradyacusia and odynacosis.. In this manner, A Thesaurus of English Word Roots places the word in as many word families as there are elements in the word. This work will interest linguists and philologists and anyone interested in the etymological aspects of

English language.
