My Thoughts provides a unique window into the mind of one of the undisputed pioneers of modern thought, the author of the 1748 classic, *The Spirit of the Laws*. From the publication in 1721 of his first masterpiece, *Persian Letters*, until his death in 1755, Montesquieu maintained notebooks in which he wrote and dictated ideas on a wide variety of topics. while adding new notes, a bibliography, and other aids to understanding the text and translation. Clark is a Visiting Professor in the Political Economy Project at Dartmouth College. He has written two books and numerous articles, mainly on the French and Scottish Enlightenments.
