Su autor la calificó de "novela malhumorada", de "nivola", de "rechifla amarga". La realidad supuesta de "Niebla" es la de un caso patológico en busca de su ser a través del diálogo, pero el autor ha organizado esta anécdota en un juego de

Después de haber estudiado en Bilbao y luego en la Universidad de Madrid, donde se doctoró en 1883, Unamuno se convirtió en un profesor universitario, enseñando en Bilbao durante siete años, para luego trasladarse a Salamanca para ocupar la cátedra de Lengua Griega y Literatura.
