His assignment was to write about a real-estate frenzy lighting up the Redneck Riviera. So Ryan Dezimmer settled in and bought a home nearby himself. Then the market crashed, and he became one of the millions of Americans who suddenly owed more on their homes than they were worth. A flood of foreclosures made it impossible to sell.
