The glories and qualities of goddess Lakshmi are well described through all the hundred and eight names and those are

explained in detail in this book with the help of Lakshmi Tantra a pancharatra text, puranas and various sacred scriptures. The specialty of Lakshmi tantra is that it is a conversation between goddess Lakshmi and Lord Indra the king of the gods. Goddess Lakshmi herself teaches Indra her glories and method of worship.
