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Fuchs corneal dystrophy is a disease of the cornea. It involves dysfunction of the endothelial cells, the inner lining of the cornea responsible for pumping fluid out of the cornea and keeping the cornea thin and clear. When the endothelial cells lose function, the cornea becomes swollen, causing blurry vision.

The cornea is the transparent tissue that covers the front of the eye. The sclera is the thick, white “wall” of the eye and the conjunctiva is the thin tissue that covers and protects the sclera. The eyelids function to protect these surface structures of the eye and to keep them moist with each blink.

Cornea and External Eye Disease. The cornea is the clear outermost layer of the eye. It covers the pupil, iris, and anterior chamber. The cornea’s main function is to refract light. The cornea is composed of proteins and cells. It does not have blood vessels, unlike most of the tissues in the human body.

Cornea and External Disease Common cornea conditions include: Corneal abrasion—an injury to the eye that scrapes the corneal surface and causes a loss of superficial tissue. Dry eye—corneal dryness caused by deficient tear production. This condition often produces a foreign body sensation, or burning feeling.

Cornea and external diseases involve the cornea and its many layers, the endothelial, iris, lens, the conjunctiva, and eyelids. The cornea can sustain damage through foreign objects, abrasions and infections, edema (swelling), and scarring. The cornea can also be damaged through genetic or degenerative disorders.

Cornea and External Diseases involve disorders of the cornea (clear, dome-shaped surface that covers the front part of the eye), iris (colored part of the eye), lens, sclera (white part of the eye), conjunctiva (thin membrane that covers the sclera) and the eyelids.
