It begins with a history of the ancient and medieval use in warfare of biological weapons and goes on to explain how governments and terrorist factions have refined this practice to include biological, chemical, and nuclear weapons as a means of coercion or as a deterrent. The volume then offers an international perspective through discussion of how other major players---Russia, Israel, India, Pakistan, and North

Though there are a number of well-written works on Chinese divination, there are none that deal with the three sophisticated devices that were employed by the Chinese Astronomical Bureau in the eleventh century and for hundreds of years thereafter. Chinese

Hidden by a veil of secrecy, these methods have always been relatively little known other than by their names.
