Capital budgeting techniques that use discounted cash flow analysis are widely recommended in the

financial literature and frequently used by business. However, there is accumulating evidence that companies are reluctant to commit funds to long-term projects. The most likely explanation is that actual experience has resulted in disappointing returns, often below a company's cost of capital. No capital budgeting technique currently in use applies probabilities to future inflow estimates, to adjust the financial analysis to previous experience with the requesting business unit. The 'discounted payback plus' technique recommended in this paper may be a reasonable alternative approach to the analysis of a capital

budgeting project, yielding more conservative results based on the expected value of cash inflows beyond the point of payback.
