Despite an often unfair reputation as being less popular, less successful, or less refined than their bona-fide Broadway counterparts, Off Broadway musicals deserve their share of critical acclaim and study. A number of shows originally staged Off Broadway have

gone on to their own successful Broadway runs, from the ever-popular *A Chorus Line* and *Rent* to more off-beat productions like *Avenue Q* and *Little Shop of Horrors*. And while it remains to be seen if other popular Off Broadway shows like *Stomp*, *Blue Man Group*, and *Altar Boyz* will make it to the larger Broadway theaters, their Off Broadway runs have been enormously successful in their own right. This book discusses more than 1,800 Off Broadway, Off Off Broadway, showcase, and workshop musical productions. Besides the individual entries, the book also includes a preface, a bibliography, and 21 appendices including a discography, filmography, a list of published scripts, and lists of musicals categorized by topic and composer.
