Dreams, in Freud's view, are all forms of wish

fulfillment"— attempts by the unconscious to resolve a conflict of some sort, whether something recent or something from the recesses of the past. Psychopathology of Everyday Life is a work based on Freud's researches into slips and parapraxes from 1897 onwards, one which became perhaps the best-known of all his writings.

In creating psychoanalysis, Freud developed therapeutic techniques such as the use of free association and discovered
