In Symbolism and Interpretation, Tzvetan Todorov examines two aspects of discourse: its production, which has traditionally been the domain of rhetoric, and its reception, which has always been the object of hermeneutics. He analyzes the diverse theories of symbolism and interpretation that have been elaborated over the centuries and considers their contribution to a general theory of verbal symbolism, discussing a wide range of thinkers, from the Sanskrit philosophers and Aristotle to the German Romantics and contemporary semioticians. Todorov begins by examining general ideas of linguistic symbolism and the interpretive process. Todorov clarifies in masterly fashion the intricacies of the many schools of thought and refines the concepts crucial to critical theory today, including the distinctions

The decades after 1750 saw the Ottoman Empire undergo tremendous stresses that culminated in the first stirrings of nationalism among Christian subjects and an irrevocable commitment to reform by the Muslim state. By 1830, Serbs and Greeks had fought successfully for autonomy or independence, and Sultan Mahmud II had prepared the way for the Tanzimat by abolishing the Janissary Corps and other discredited institutions. In spite of the importance of this era for both Ottoman and Balkan history, marking as it does the transition from the pre-modern to the modern, scholars have shown remarkably little interest in the factors triggering such important developments. MODERN ALBANIA

This book surveys the relations between Catholics outside and inside the Ottoman Empire from 1453 to 1923. After the fall of Constantinople the only large Latin Catholic group to be incorporated into the sultan's domain were the Genoese who lived in Galata, across the Golden Horn from the Byzantine capital. Over the next few decades Turkish armies pushed into the Balkans, overrunning the Catholic population of Albania, Bosnia and Hungary. In the Orient, the sixteenth century saw the Maronites of Lebanon, the Latins of Palestine and most of the Greek islands, which once held Latin Catholic communities, come under Turkish rule. Papal response to the loss of these communities was initially a call to the crusade, but response from West European monarchs was disappointing. Their concerns were closer to home. French interest, however, lay in an alliance with the Turks against the Habsburgs. As a bonus, the Catholics of the Ottoman world received a protector at the Porte in the person of the French ambassador. The book traces the subsequent history of the Latin Catholics and each of the Eastern Catholic churches in the Ottoman Empire until its dissolution in 1923.

Libri është një rrëfim grotesk për pikëpyetje të shumta që janë shtruar gjithkund për botën dhe jetën e sotme. Këto duken mjaft të trazuar, për shkak të ndryshimeve të mëdha e të rënda në natyrë, si dhe ngaqë rendi shoqëror aktual, me gjithë dallimet në vende të ndryshme, është njëfarësoj në krizë. Edhe pse tema disi absurde e të vështira për t'u rrokur, autori ka vendosur "t'i hyjë detit më këmbë", duke ia besuar zgjidhjen e pikëpyetjeve globale personazhit të tij grotesk, profesorit në pension Ndrio Bedalla. Pikërisht për shkak të konstatimeve e përjetimeve të dhimbshme sa i takon Botës së sotme dhe plagëve shoqërore në rritje, profesori i ëuditshëm vendos të ndërmarrë një MISION; ëndrra e tij, dëshira e tij fatale, është ta ndryshojë dhe ta shpëtojë vendin, por edhe Rajonin e Rruzullin tokësor. Për t'ia arritur kësaj, Ndrio Bedalla krijon një ekip, ku nuk mungojnë zëdhënësi e asistenti, por edhe personazhe të tjerë, të qenë e të paqenë. Ai publikon

një program të gjerë, dhe herë pas here, shpall Komunikata e Qarkore, të cilave iu beson shumë; ndërkaq, ai krijon disa lidhje me organizma e tituj të nderuar nëpër botë, jep e merr me ta, anipse shpesh herë duke bërë vetëm monolog. Personazhi i frymëzuar i romanit të Vangjush Saros, agjitor pareshtur për rreziqet që i kanosen Botës, ndërkohë që me gjithë shpirt shpreson të realizojë gjëra pothuaj të pamundura. Në mënyrë të veçantë, profesori nuk ua përton takimeve në mjedise të ndryshme: në azile, në shkolla, në kopshte, te bizneset; dhe në këdo rast, përpiqet të japë mend e të ndryshojë rrjedhën fatale të jetës. Ai është naiv dhe shkon me bindjen se Bota do ta dëgjojë dhe do të lëvizë në drejtimin e duhur. Idetë e profesorit, në fakt janë alternative, edhe pse ndonjëherë të ëuditshme; por misioni i tij është patetik, për më tepër ndërmerret në relieve të brishta e tragjikomike të botës dhe të jetës së sotme. Fjalimet e tij, nismat dhe aksionet e tij, nuk kuptohen; dhe takimet shpesh përfundojnë në aventura gazmore, deri diku edhe të trishta. Personazhi (i dyzuar) i këtij romani humoristik, nuk është një hero; nuk është as sharlatan. Ndonjëherë duket pak si tepër grotesk. Ka momente që nuk gjendet kund një njeri më serioz se ai. Ndrio Bedalla është, njëfarësoj, viktimë dhe mesazheri i një realiteti të sëmure, në gjendje akute. Në parathënie e librit, shkrimtari dhe kritik i letrar Fatmir Terziu nënvizon: "Në këtë prozë, edhe vetë Bota është duale dhe misterioze; Bota, ku ambienti është deri kundërmues dhe dualiteti kapërcen vetë formatin e tij plot hije dhe dritëhije, deri në "brejtjen e Planetit". "Misioni" është një roman plot humor dhe episode të këndshme; ai e tërheq, mandej e zbavit dhe e vë në mendime lexuesin; për një sërë pyetje, që edhe ai i ka në mendje kaheë.
