Best known for his work with Yes, a group prone to sudden upheavals, and AOR supergroup Asia, Steve Howe's passage through these and other bands is a roller-coaster ride of constant touring, tense recording sessions and frequent trips to all corners of the globe. A workaholic, he soon realised that the

temptations of the rock 'n' roll lifestyle weren't for him and instead dedicated his life to excellence in musicianship. After spells in psychedelic bands of the late sixties, he was invited to join Yes in 1970, thus finding himself in a spotlight that shines to this day. As well as Yes and Asia, Steve has led bands of his own, released numerous solo recordings in many different musical styles and amassed a legendary collection of priceless stringed instruments. All of this and his many encounters with other celebrated guitarists are recounted in All My Yesterdays, the first ever autobiography by a member of Yes.
